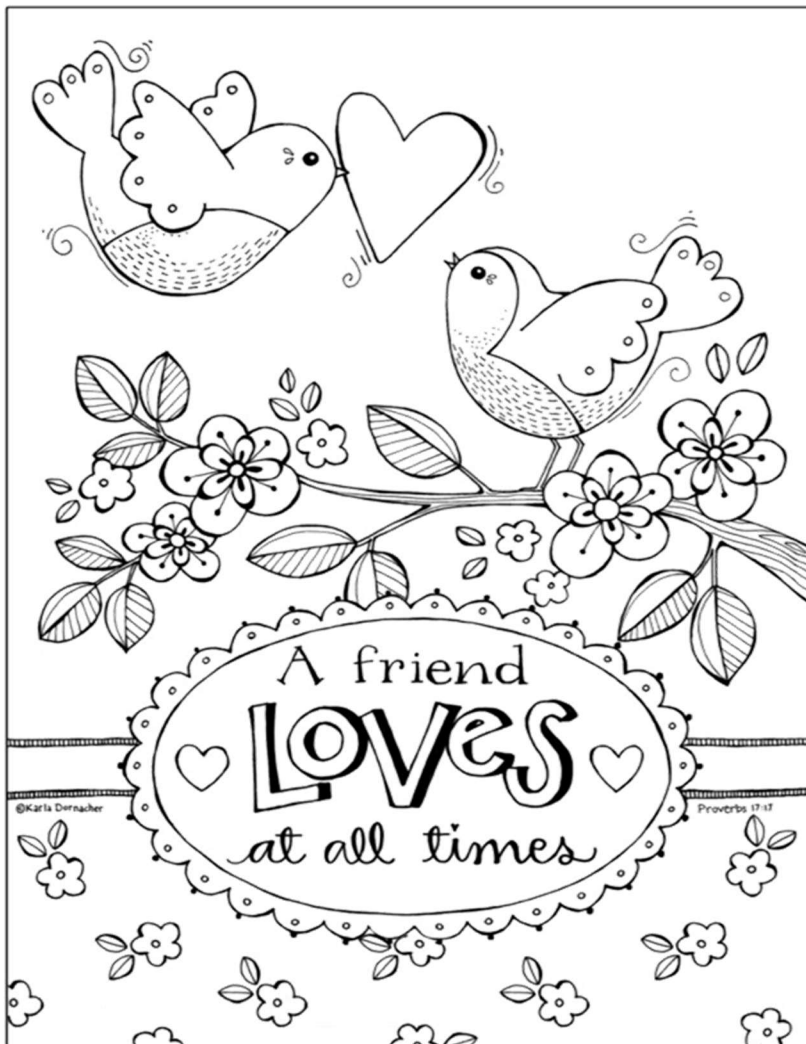
Good morning everyone! We are so happy that you are taking part in our worship with us this morning.
