Today we will be taking the morning and evening lessons in a study of Acts 2, but it will not be a traditional approach. We know that we are supposed to preach Christ and him crucified (1 Cor 2.2), but I am looking at the specific content to answer how can you preach Christ crucified? How did Peter do that very thing here? What does he talk about in this sermon that can help teach me how to be better prepared in conversations that I have opportunity to have with people I know I need to reach?

I am going to bring out four things from chapter 2 that will specifically help us put meat on the bone of what it means to preach Christ and him crucified. The study that we do today can be something you mirror at home. Take the rest of the sermons in Acts, for example, and examine what the core content is in each lesson. When you discover those additional ideas, then add them to this picture of chapter 2 we develop today for an even broader landscape of what it means to preach Christ and him crucified.

We are commanded to preach Christ and him crucified, and we want to do that. Today's lesson will help us, and we will examine the context closely for lessons as well.
