Today we will finish our study of the first two chapters of Joel. I would urge you to continue your own study into chapter 3, and complete the book. There is great benefit to looking closely at a text, like we have done in these opening chapters, so you can be sure that you would benefit from a detailed study of the last chapter. What treasures are there, waiting for you to “discover” by putting the message under a microscope? God will bless you and bring more knowledge into your life if you will engage with that text.

Joel, though Old Testament prophecy, still teaches lessons that need to be learned. I would suggest that when you study other Old Testament prophets, you would find teaching that can be applied to your knowledge of God, and His will. You would be blessed, just as in this study of one prophet (Joel), you would gain riches by submitting to the word of God found in all the prophets.

May God bless you this week. Read through all the prophets. “Everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope” (Rm 15.4). The prophets will produce this EXACT result.
