"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil." (Matthew 6:9b-13)

It is an oft-quoted, oft-used prayer that is appropriately dubbed the "model" prayer because it was the answer Jesus gave when the apostles asked Him to teach them to pray. (Luke 11:1-4) It is used by numerous members of the church, teams, groups, etc. as a way to keep their focus pure when they bow their heads to pray and it has been recited by dignitaries, movie stars, and billions of other people throughout history.

What is the intention of this prayer? It is not intended to be a rote memorization item that is put forth in place of a genuine conversation. It is not intended to become tired or passion-less. It is not intended to be required before each and every conversation. Rather, it is intended to keep the one praying focused on who they are speaking with while encouraging them to open their hearts and lives up before the Creator of the world.

This morning we are examining another prayer of Jesus. What can we take away from examining the intense and constant prayer life of Jesus?
