Sometimes we read passages in the Bible, and we envision ourselves SO far away from the example we might be studying, or the teaching that is being given. What I mean is that we read a passage and do not honestly evaluate ourselves to reason that we need to apply the word to our lives. Part of the reason we do that is because we have this inward tendency to think more highly of ourselves than we ought. Paul warns the Romans, "Do not think of yourselves more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourselves with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you" (Rm 12.3).

This morning, the text will be **easy** for you to follow, and you will immediately grasp the understanding of what Jesus is teaching. But when we come to the application, you will be tempted to think "more highly of yourself." Paul would teach us that we **MUST** be on our guard against doing that. Let's open our hearts, and lives, to the Lord, who is our Righteous Judge. And ask for the wisdom of our Father to help us determine if any of these ways might be ours. And if they are, then we must seek to fix these things with the help of God, and encouragement from our family.
