Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel (2 Tim 2.8).

Jesus raised from the dead. We understand how this works. Jesus died and was raised to life through the Holy Spirit, and was “appointed the Son of God in power” (Rm 1.3-4). That is the perspective of AFTER the resurrection. What about BEFORE His resurrection?

Paul says that Jesus “descended from David.” How can that be the gospel? What is the good news about Jesus, coming from David? And what is the significance of the statement David would make (in Psalm 110), about the One who would be the “descendant” of David?

Let’s put this together in our study today, and make personal application to this brilliant truth so visible in the OT Psalms. It is more than a lineage!
