How do I mature as a Christian?  
 - Learn from my own mistakes  
 - Learn from the mistakes of others  
 - Prepare myself for the battles that are coming  
 - Understand what is available to me through Christ  
 - Stay focused on what I am supposed to be living for

This morning we close this brief series on the measure of maturity by discussing the responsibility that comes with being a maturing Christian. There is no question that churches are filled all over the globe with people who are striving to grow and develop in their faith. This church is no different! However, we must be brutally honest with ourselves and place ourselves in one of the following three areas:

- 1) Developing Christian - This is someone who is still an infant in their faith. Someone who is new to their faith, or returning to a faith they had let stall. The expectations for this person would be that they would be zealous in their Bible study and in their desire to seek after the paths of Christ.
- 2) Mature Christian - This is someone who is developed in their faith. They do not "know it all", but they have been a long-time student of the word and feel very comfortable explaining themselves spiritually. The expectations for this person are that they would continue in their studying AND would be striving to teach others (both in their church family and out).
- 3) Lacking Christian - This is someone who has been faith-filled in the past, but now has become stagnant or complacent or has left their faith behind altogether. The apostle Peter explains that if someone is not making every effort to add to their faith with virtue, knowledge, self-control, steadfastness, godliness, brotherly affection, and love, then they are ineffective and unfruitful. (2 Peter 1:5-8) It is this person who has become blind and has forgotten they were cleansed from their sins. (2 Peter 1:9)

Where are you today? It would be very easy to dismiss this question and hide as a number 1 or a number 2, but if you are really a number 3, are you willing to repent (a joyous realization) and be cleansed from those sins? We pray for that type of maturity for everyone who reads these words today.
