Today we will begin a 3-part study on disfellowship. We will be taking I Cor 5 as our text, and we will cover every word of the text in order to learn what our role is in the body of Christ. Everyone has a role that they play towards their brother.

Whoever spares the rod hates their children, but the one who loves their children is careful to discipline them (Prov 13.24). This ancient wisdom comes from the word of God. It is where we learn the principle of discipline, and its value to the lives of our children. If it is designed for children, then all of us, who are children of God, should acclaim the value of discipline, done by God (Heb 12.4-11).

God has called for discipline to be employed in His family. The reason God does this is not necessary for us understand in order for us to obey His instruction, but it is instructional to put church discipline next to parental discipline. God says that those who do not discipline, do not love their children. Those who discipline love their children, and want what is best for their children.

If we are the spiritual family of God, then shouldn't discipline be expected? The answer is, yes. This is consistent with the teaching of the word. Today we will study a chapter about church discipline.
