Today we will be thinking on the suffering of Christ.

What things happened to Him? We struggle to comprehend all of what He suffered. The Hebrew writer says that He "endured the cross, scorning its shame (Heb 12.2). That statement is all we get from the writer, but how much more could have been said? The word used in that passage means, "to stay under, figuratively, to bear under trials." Jesus bore under the trial of the cross, and did not seek relief until His work was completed. He suffered because He knew that we couldn't handle the suffering. He suffered to the very end, demonstrating incredible perseverance.

There was shame associated with the cross as well. "Shame or disgrace (abstractly or concretely), dishonesty, a thing to be ashamed of," is how the word shame is defined. Did Jesus have a reason to be ashamed of Himself? Absolutely not. But shame was associated with that kind of death. He was humiliated, and despised.

We will let His suffering be our backdrop for our meditations today. What a blessing it will be for all of us. I pray it will promote our love for Him.
