Bring Your Bible Sunday

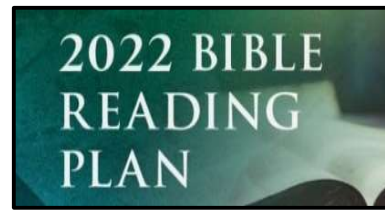
