Content or Complacent?

These two words are sadly so close that people can believe they are content, when they are actually complacent. Contentment is defined as a state of happiness and satisfaction. Complacency is defined as a feeling of smug or uncritical satisfaction with oneself or one's achievements. When we examine those definitions, the differences are obvious, but in a person's life sometimes that line gets blurred.

Contentment is a learned behavior. As Paul would write in Philippians 4:11-13, "11 Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned, in whatever situation I am, to be content. 12 I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. 13 I can do all things through him who strengthens me." The picture then is that we are in a constant state of growing, maturing, and learning.

Complacency is actually an in-born trait that we have to overcome. As the wisest man that ever lived Solomon wrote, "28 Then they will call upon me, but I will not answer; they will seek me diligently but will not find me. 29 Because they hated knowledge and did not choose the fear of the Lord, 30 would have none of my counsel and despised all my reproof, 31 therefore they shall eat the fruit of their way, and have their fill of their own devices. 32 For the simple are killed by their turning away, and **the complacency of fools destroys them; 33 but whoever listens to me will dwell secure and will be at ease, without dread of disaster.**" (Proverbs 1:28-33, emphasis added)
