Hudson Taylor, a Protestant missionary to China in the 1800s, was interviewing some young people who had volunteered for the Lord's service. He asked several practical questions to find out how well qualified they were for the life they were anticipating.

"And why do you wish to go as a foreign missionary?" He asked.

"I want to reach others across the sea because Christ has commanded us to go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature," one person replied.

Another said, "I want to go because millions are dying without ever having heard of Jesus, the only One who can save them." Others had similar answers.

Hudson Taylor looked at them thoughtfully for a moment and then said, "All of your motives are good, but I fear they will fail you in times of severe testing and tribulation -- especially if you are confronted with the possibility of having to face death for your testimony. The only motive that will enable you to remain true is stated in 2 Corinthians 5:14. Christ's love controlling/constraining you will keep you faithful in every situation."

Is it possible that we have good motives, but are not controlled by the love of Christ? Is it possible that for so long we have been convinced that we are good only to find out that we are still controlled by our own desires?

This morning as we examine this familiar passage, I pray that we are all motivated, constrained, compelled, and controlled by the love of Christ and if not... then may we have the courage to admit it and make a change.
