"1 He entered Jericho and was passing through. 2 And behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus. He was a chief tax collector and was rich. 3 And he was seeking to see who Jesus was, but on account of the crowd he could not, because he was small in stature. 4 So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him, for he was about to pass that way. 5 And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today." 6 So he hurried and came down and received him joyfully. 7 And when they saw it, they all grumbled, "He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." 8 And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor. And if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I restore it fourfold." 9 And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. 10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

It is incredible to consider that when Jesus was on this earth, He was not here for a "tour" or a "signing", but instead Jesus came to work. He was quite literally, a man on a mission.

What was that mission? It is outlined in Luke 19:10 as being a mission to "seek and save the lost." If that was the mission for the Chosen One, the Holy One of God, then should it not stand to reason that it would be the mission for those who call themselves His followers?

Let's consider the Mission of Jesus this morning and the prize that lies before us this evening. I pray that we all can take seriously the mission we are called to.
