"1 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, 2 for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. 3 This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time."

When was the last time we stopped and prayed the following model?

Supplication - This is the action of begging for something earnestly or humbly. What have we been begging God to do, to work out, to help with? Are we asking humbly? Are we asking with the expectation that He will act?

Prayer - This is a solemn request or offering of thanksgiving. The respect shown to God ought to be evident when we pray. Are we praying in solitude with respect shown to our Creator? Are we pairing our requests with words of gratitude?

Intercession - This is the act of intervening on behalf of another person. Are we praying to God on behalf of other people? Are we praying for our enemies and those who persecute us? Are we openly praying for the lost? Are we praying for our families, our friends, and those we come in contact with?

Thanksgiving - Simply put, this is the expression of gratitude. Are we thankful for the everyday blessings given to us by God? Are we thankful for the influence of the good people we come in contact with?

Stop and consider the next time you pray... Am I truly spending time in conversation with God in these areas or am I rushing through the conversation to move on to something else? --SW
