If someone came up to you and shoved you, what would your response be? How would you handle yourself? Would you shove them back, would you question them, would you immediately get angry?

What if they exclaimed "I am so sorry, I thought you were someone else!" Would that change your reaction? What if they then extended their hand, asked for your forgiveness and even offered to buy your lunch? As much as it pains me and embarrasses me, I am afraid there is a part of me that would want to simply walk away from them and stay mad for a while.

That is what happens many times in our lives: things happen, we make snap decisions or judgements, and then we are unable to loosen ourselves from those decisions/judgements. Our perception of that moment, even if it is totally wrong, has become our reality. In some cases, this belief that our perception is concrete can be dangerous because it can ruin our influence on someone or even prevent us from speaking the truth about the gospel to them.

In our study this morning, we will examine a time when Paul called out the perceptions and introduced reality. The challenge for us will be to examine ourselves and see if our walk is based in reality or merely perceptions.
