As we come to the final two lessons in our series concerning the need to walk in rhythm with God, I pray that we have all honestly taken a look at our lives to see whether or not we are in step, in rhythm, in cadence with God. This morning, we look at what it means to walk in rhythm with the heart of God based on our examination of a man who was labeled as being one who was "after God's own heart." In this examination, we will see what happens when we follow our own heart and our own desires and what happens when we are truly chasing after the heart of God as outlined in His word.

Tonight we will look at an Old Testament account that illustrates this very concept. As we look at Abram, Sarai, and Hagar, there is an obvious lesson that leaps from the page into our personal business. Are we the type of people who try to take control away from God and do things our own way? What is the result of this power grab? This account helps us to understand better how God sees us and how God helps us even when we think we can do it all on our own.

I pray that both lessons will help us grow closer to God and influence more people to want to know about Him.
