Today we begin two studies that will take us into the new year focused on what God consistently does for us (grace) and what is expected of us daily (the book of James). I pray that as we work through this topic and this book that we grow closer to God, closer to His Word, and closer to one another as we strive to reach the goal of heaven together.

Grace is a topic that seemingly gets one of two treatments: 1) it is ignored because the teacher or audience does not understand it or 2) it is over-taught because there is a lack of spiritual discipline being adhered to. As I have been digging into this word, its meaning, its effect on the human condition, and its power to save, I have been overwhelmed at the goodness of God. I pray that you will have a similar response as we move through this conversation.

The book of James, often called the "Proverbs of the New Testament", is a practical, living document that still holds weight today (and will for the duration of time). There are so many lessons that can be taught from this short letter that it will be difficult to get them all in by the end of the year. (However, thank you goes to Bobby Street for the great job he did using James 3 to teach us about the power that our words, speech, tongue, mouth have, and therefore I will move past that chapter when we arrive there. -- Great job Bobby)

I pray that these studies will spark your spiritual fire and lead you into a deeper appreciation for your Creator and His Word.
