Nearing His death, Jesus had dinner in Bethany with some of His disciples. In Matthew 26 & Mark 14, we are told that it took place at Simon the leper's home. In John 12, we are told that Lazarus was there. Could you imagine beholding that scene – Jesus in the midst of lives that He had totally transformed. Simon could not have been the host of such an event, had not Jesus healed him. Lazarus could not have been there, had not Jesus resurrected him. Witnessing this moment might have led us to do what Mary did, anointing Jesus with expensive oil – an act that brought ridicule and that secured a permanent place in the gospel story.

Jesus sat in a household of transformed lives. He left behind a wake of transformed lives.

As we look around the household of God, may we remain in perpetual awe of the transformed lives in our midst. May we strive to leave a wake of transformed lives behind us, as we bring people to Jesus.

We all come from varying backgrounds, varying degrees of faith, and varying issues that may plague us day in and day out, but we all come with a desire to be more like the One who died for us on that cross. May today be a day of dismissing pettiness and frustration to allow the transformative Word of God deeper into our hearts.
