The example we set for others does matter. While it is their decision to either become a Christian or not, it is our duty to re-present Christ to everyone we come in contact with.

One way this happens is by our attitude. If I am constantly bragging, constantly complaining, and never seeming satisfied, then what have I done to influence someone towards Christ? If anything, I have shown them that Christianity is no different than their workplace and there is no reason to change. However, if I try to be gentle, speak the truth in love, live optimistically, and remain humble, a person sees this Christian life as something far different than the world.

One other simple way to re-present Christ is in the way we dress. Before we eye-roll too hard, this is still an issue today.
