As you have (perhaps) picked up on, these things have centered around the example we need to set in all areas of our life. We have based this study out of Titus 2 (which we covered the last couple of weeks) where Paul is trying to encourage the early church in their attitude and behavior.

THIS MORNING: One of the major things that is different today from when the Scriptures were written is the advent of social media and instant reaction/messaging. When we are able to instantly respond to the things going on, we oftentimes are relying on our emotions which can be faulty. This makes social media a place where emotions run rampant, truth takes a backseat and people say things that they would normally never say. As we study this morning, I know that instinctually some of the audience will roll their eyes as we talk about this, others will glaze over because they do not believe it applies to them, still others will get angry because they feel attacked, and finally there will be a small group that listens and applies the message in an effort to improve their influence.

May we all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and even slower to excuse/rationalize/justify.

THIS AFTERNOON: We will conclude our lesson from a couple of weeks ago on Jeremiah and excuse-making.
