"But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere. For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other a fragrance from life to life. Who is sufficient for these things? For we are not, like so many, peddlers of God's word, but as men of sincerity, as commissioned by God, in the sight of God we speak in Christ." (2 Corinthians 2:15-17)

THIS MORNING: We are looking at the triumph we find in Christ when we live as forgiven people that forgive others. It is imperative that we present the proper aroma (as strange as that may sound to us) to the world around us because for those that are listening with open hearts it can mean salvation. There have been times in our lives where we have felt betrayed by someone and there are times in our lives that we have been the one who betrayed someone. What do we do to survive betrayal? How do we move past it? Thankfully, the apostle Paul, through inspiration, gives us insight into how we can achieve that goal.
