THIS MORNING: The beautiful nature of a real relationship with Jesus Christ is that we are allowed to experience and see things in a completely different way. One of those things that we are allowed to experience is the new covenant between God and man. Through our obedient faith, we enter into a covenant with God through the blood of His Son and can live in hope (faithful expectation) even while existing in a world that may not understand or comprehend that hope.

This morning we are going to examine the way that Paul wrote and explained this new covenant and its beauty. There is no question that we are forever blessed because of our Heavenly Father and His love for us when we truly choose to live for Him. We pray that you will leave this morning encouraged and uplifted as you go into the world as a faithful child of God.

TONIGHT: We will begin a look at a series of Psalms that point us to the greatness of God. Tonight we look at Psalm 2 and see the power of God on full display. When a person understands the power of God, the glory of God, and the love of God, they cannot help but desire to be on His side. The question for tonight comes from a tumultuous time in Israel's history and it is one that we must be prepared to answer like the sons of Levi did.

"25 And when Moses saw that the people had broken loose (for Aaron had let them break loose, to the derision of their enemies), 26 then Moses stood in the gate of the camp and said, "Who is on the Lord's side? Come to me." And all the sons of Levi gathered around him." -- (Exodus 32:25-26)
