THIS MORNING: There are a handful of topics that people typically shy away from or recoil when they are discussed. In some cases, the topics are matters of opinion and therefore do not disturb the eternal destination of the participants (i.e. what exactly happens to our bodies when we die? Will I know people in heaven? How will I know them?, etc). However, in other cases, it can be a conversation about something that is a matter of what Scripture says. In those conversations, it is vital that we understand the context in which something was written and dig deeper to be certain we are applying it correctly to our lives.

One such topic is the idea of giving of our means. We should be familiar with the numerous passages that speak about this specific act and realize that God is calling us to give. How much and how often a report is needed may be something that could be debated, but the fact remains that we are called to give. This morning, we hope to examine the Scriptures and grow in our knowledge concerning generosity, the work of the church, and our part in those things.
