"5 So also the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great things. How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire! 6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by hell. 7 For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and sea creature, can be tamed and has been tamed by mankind, 8 but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. 9 With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. 10 From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers, these things ought not to be so." ---- James 3:5-10

What is it that you say to show people that you are a Christian? What words do you use and what statements do you make that people immediately know reveals your faith?

When you open your mouth and unleash the weapon within your face, what kind of damage is being done? How often do you hide behind excuses or losing your temper? How many times have you apologized for what you said only to say the same thing moments later?

The tongue is a violent weapon when we avoid taking responsibility for it. The tongue can be violent when we do not mature in our faith. The tongue can be destructive when we forget to keep it under control.

This morning we look at James 3 and why so many people have ignored the reality of this chapter.
