There have been numerous studies done throughout history concerning how people respond to trouble. There are those who have spent countless hours examining the brain and central nervous system to try and map out why we respond to trouble in a certain way. However, what we have come to realize through all of these studies is that everyone responds differently to almost every situation (even if the difference is slight).

Typically there are two explanations applied to the reaction of humanity to trouble:

- 1) Fight
- 2) Flight

When one runs from trouble, many times they can find themselves in a situation like Jonah where God has asked them to stand up to the issue at hand only for them to run in the other direction. Other times, it is simply a conversation about fear and why one is afraid of a particular thing. In the spiritual context, when we are approached by temptation or when we have sinned, do we attempt to run away from the consequences/punishment, or do we take responsibility for our actions and words so that we can begin the sanctification process?

When one stands and fights trouble, a positive aspect is that they normally gain the respect of everyone that witnessed their struggle. A negative aspect that can be seen in these moments is that the reason for fighting could be selfish or could steer the issue into a direction it was not intended to go. Fighting for what is right is scriptural, fighting to fight is not.

Ultimately, Christians are expected to deal with conflict (or trouble) by fully relying on God. It is our calling, responsibility, and duty to trust God that He knows what we should do with the troubles in our lives.
