How does one view the sacred things? How ought one view the sacred things? When did we get to the point where worship became just another thing in a world full of things? Join in our study this morning and let us look honestly at what the church needs to pay closer attention to.

What have I done to get ready to worship?

1. Get Prepared Earlier
 - Ecclesiastes 5:1a - "Guard your steps when you go to the house of God."
 - The indication is not to get prepared for worship once you are in your sacred pew and everyone else has made it to theirs. Instead, the indication is that one should prepare themselves to enter into worship as they are going to the house of God.
 - Hebrews 12:28-29 - Offering worship to God is not something haphazardly done, but with tremendous focus and proper planning.
2. Be Eager to Listen
 - Ecclesiastes 5:1b-3 - "To draw near to listen is better than to offer the sacrifice of fools... Be not rash with your mouth, nor let your heart be hasty to utter a word before God..."
 - Humility must be present in our preparation. Active listening leads to active learning, and those things will inevitably bring about spiritual growth.
 - John 10:1-16 - The voice of God must be listened to and followed.
3. Mean What You Say
 - Ecclesiastes 5:4-6 - "When you vow a vow to God, do not delay paying it, for He has no pleasure in fools."
 - Have we made numerous promises to God that we have not kept? Do we truly understand and grasp what it means to commit to God in fullness of spirit?
 - James 5:11-12 - Simply put, James says to mean what you say when you say it.

- Ecclesiastes 5:7 - "For when dreams increase and words grow many, there is vanity; but God is the one you must fear."
