Several weeks ago we looked at some things we can know about heaven. In that study, it (hopefully) filled you with joy to know that our God has truly prepared a place for us to live with Him for eternity. There are many verses to look at concerning what has been said about heaven, but for the sake of space, I am listing most of them in the points below. I pray that as we study even more today about what a knowledge of heaven can do for us in the here and now that you will be encouraged, uplifted and challenged to share that great news with others.

### Six Things We Can Know About Heaven

1. Heaven will just be better (Rom 8:18; 2 Corinthians 4:16-17; Phil. 1:20-23)
2. Heaven will be rewarding (Matthew 19:23-30; 2 Timothy 4:6-8) — what makes it worth it? JESUS
3. Heaven will be unfathomably amazing (Revelation 4:1-11; 5:11-14)
4. Heaven will be crowded (Revelation 7:9-10)
5. Heaven will be home (Hebrews 11:13-16; Philippians 3:20-21; John 14:1-3)
6. Heaven will be forever (Revelation 5:1-14)
