What about if someone threatened you with crucifixion in the days of Jesus? That was a tactic or mode of death preferred by the Romans because of its humiliation and pain. A person did not die from the wounds found in the wrists or feet, but rather they suffocated due to their eventual exhaustion and inability to push their body high enough to catch a breath. If a criminal were not dying fast enough for the Roman soldiers' liking, they would use a heavy, wooden club to break the legs of that person, causing them to expire faster.

This information is provided for our consideration today because there are some things that we hold so dear that it could be used as an attack point for those who might desire to see us forfeit our faith. Therefore it is all the more important that we refocus our minds constantly on what Jesus did for us and what God gave for us.
