There has been much debate and conversation over the years about a particular gift that was given to the apostles and then passed on to others. The power was intended to lead people into a deeper faith in God and help prove the message of the gospel. There was an intended purpose and a definite timeline put on this power (or gift) and to infer that these things are still going on today is to disregard the teachings of Scripture.

The power or gift being discussed is the power/gift of speaking in tongues. There are groups today who proudly proclaim that they can speak in tongues and when the moment comes, they make noise that is not understandable and is definitely not of God. Paul did not mess around when it came to the gift of speaking in tongues and openly proclaimed himself to be far more advanced than anyone else in this regard. Even with this statement of real power, Paul would go on to state "I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you. Nevertheless, in church I would rather speak five words with my mind in order to instruct others, than ten thousand words in a tongue." (1 Corinthians 14:18-19) The teaching done by Paul here is obvious... the teaching done from a heart in tune with God and His Word will accomplish far more than even being able to speak in a foreign/unrecognizable tongue.
