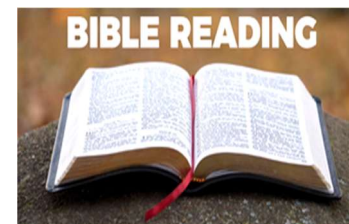
Online Pictorial Church Directory
