My grandmother, Beulah Miles Canerdy, made sure we knew her brothers and sisters and I cannot express how grateful I am for that. He would call me on my birthday every few years and would often prank me before breaking into "Happy Birthday". When my grandmother passed away in March of 2020, we asked Uncle Clifford to speak at her funeral. Even while under the weather, he delivered a beautiful memorial and comforted all of us even as he mourned. Some time after the service, he sat down and called all of us who had a part in the service to tell us how proud he was of us and how much he loved us.

I will do my best to make him proud... I will do my best to keep "raising that boy" of mine on the right track... and I will always be proud that I knew him. I just wish I had five more minutes to tell him.
