Over the course of the next two quarters (April-June and July-September), our front page of the bulletin will be dedicated to materials from Hebrews 11. The challenge put forth in front of you by this idea is that you will read these items, examine your faith and grow in your discipleship as you implement the things taught. --- The elders and Scott

Today's Reading - Hebrews 11:1-40 What's for dinner? What am I going to wear? When do we have to be there? Do I have to?

Life seems to be a series of questions, some important and some not so much. One of the most important questions we must ask ourselves and answer is this: "How do I please God?" The Hebrews writer gives us that answer in chapter 11, verse six: "And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him."

We please God through faith. The message is so emphatic, the writer says it is impossible to please God without it. If faith is paramount to pleasing God, then we have another question: "What is Faith?" The Hebrews writer answers this question in Hebrews 11:1-3: "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the people of old received their commendation. By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible."

Verse one seems paradoxical with words like assurance and conviction buttressed against words like hope and unseen. So, what does it mean? Faith is the consistent and enduring outlook of complete trust in God.

Verse two tells us the people of Scripture were seen and approved by God for their acts of faith.

Verse three tells us faith leads to understanding and acceptance of the truth that God is the omni-God - He is the All-Powerful, All-Knowing, All-Loving, All-Present Creator and sustainer of the universe, us, and the world to come.
