Continuing the look at Hebrews 11 in hopes that your faith is strengthened and you are encouraged... *(Special thanks to Mike Jackson)*

Today's Reading – Genesis 5:21–24

Can you imagine living 365 years and having a full faith and trust in God for all those years? There was a man who did just that, and his name was Enoch. In Genesis 5:21-24 Scripture tells us that Enoch fathered Methuselah when he was 65 years old. Methuselah is known for his very old age. But there is something else uniquely special about Enoch, he had incredible faith in God. Hebrews 11:5-6 tells us that Enoch did not see death, meaning he did not experience a mortal death but was raised to Heaven alive. Can you imagine? He was the only one during this time who did not experience physical death. This passage also tells us that before Enoch was taken by God, God was pleased with Enoch. Verse six also says that without faith it is impossible to please God. Enoch had extreme faith. In 2 Kings 2:1-11, we learn Elijah also did not see a mortal death and was taken to Heaven by God. These were the only two men in the entire Bible that did not experience a physical death. There are two other mentions of Enoch in the New Testament. Luke briefly mentions Enoch in Luke 3:37 as being the son of Methuselah and Enoch is also mentioned in the book of Jude. Jude 1:14-15 says "It was also about these that Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his holy ones, to execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of

ungodliness that they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him.”

Enoch

What I want us to focus on today about Enoch is a certain phrase in Genesis. In Genesis 5:24 it states that Enoch “walked with God.” Thinking about your own faith, on a scale of 1-10 how would you rate your faith in God? Does it vary from day to day or from week to week? If so, what do you think is causing your faith to waver? What does it mean to “walk with God?” When I think about “walking with God,” I can’t help but get a comforting feeling that God is with me. Only when I know I am being obedient to the teachings of Jesus Christ do I feel this way. When I allow Satan to creep into my life, I feel apart from God. It’s a very cold and lonely feeling. My way of overcoming this is to pray several times every single day, not missing a scheduled time or day. Don’t take a vacation from God. He wants to hear from you. HE CREATED YOU, he has a vested interest, and he wants you to succeed!
