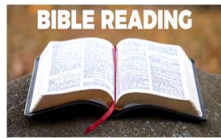

**Today's Reading – Hebrews 11:8-19 Abraham**

Abraham is regarded by some to be the most important person in the Bible, with the exception of Jesus. He is considered a father figure for three separate religions – Muslims, Jews and Christians. Christians have always seen the Lord as the fulfillment of a promise made to Abraham – that all peoples of the earth would be blessed through him.

Maybe one of the most significant characteristics of this man is that Jehovah called Himself “the God of Abraham!” Let the impact of that sink in! Besides the account of his life in Genesis, Abraham is mentioned more than 40 times in the Old Testament and more than 70 times in the New Testament. Three times in Scripture he is called what no other man is ever called: “the friend of God.” (2 Chronicles 20:7, Isaiah 41:8 and James 2:23) How would you like to be described like that?

Abraham's importance in God's plan is immediately seen when we start reading the New Testament. It begins with these words, "The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham." (**Matthew 1:1**)

Our own close relationship with Abraham is explained by Paul when he writes in **Galatians 3:29**, "And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise." As Abraham's seed, we also need to try to inherit his faith!
