Today's Reading - Genesis 12:1-20; 16:1-18:15 Sarah

Sarah trusted God in tough situations and has been recognized as a godly woman of faith in the book of Hebrews.

Hebrews 11:11 - "By faith Sarah herself received power to conceive, even when she was past the age, since she considered him faithful who had promised."

Her life story has many lessons we need to learn and exhibit in our own lives. She submitted herself to Abraham and God, enduring searing heat and even living in a tent as they trekked through the wilderness. I doubt she had any idea what her future would be like when she agreed to leave her family, wealth, and position to follow her husband, not knowing where they were going but faithful because God was leading him. She even agreed to lie to Pharaoh to protect Abraham when famine forced them to detour to Egypt where she hid in Pharaoh's harem, trusting God to save her even though her husband didn't protect her.

Was Sarah perfect? Of course not! She, like all of us, often faltered in her faith. The key to her success was she considered God faithful, even when she was not. Christians can and will face tests or trials regardless of age and that was certainly the case in her life!
