Today's Reading – Genesis 17:15–21 & Genesis 22  
*Isaac*

How do you react when faced with life's toughest choices? When the right thing to do is the hardest thing to do, how do you proceed, and what are the consequences?

In Genesis 22, Abraham was presented with one such situation. God instructed him to take his son Isaac to the land of Moriah and sacrifice him as a burnt offering. Although this command must have been disheartening to Abraham, he proceeded with faithful obedience, laying Isaac on the altar and beginning the process to sacrifice him, until the angel of the LORD called from heaven to stop him.

We often read this account and marvel at the faith of Abraham, and rightfully so, but do we ever pause to consider how this event shaped Isaac's faith for the rest of his life? Dr. Dave Miller of Apologetics Press, in his article "*How old was Isaac when Abraham was told to offer him?*" points to linguistic data supporting the idea that Isaac wasn't a young boy when on Mount Moriah, but a young man, likely in his late-teens or twenties, old enough that he carried the wood up the mountain for the burnt offering. Each day, our children are watching us. They listen to what we say and watch how we act, especially in difficult times or when doing right is not easy. This application isn't only for parents, though. Grandparents, aunts, uncles, neighbors, and other adult mentors also play an important role in shaping the faith of children and young adults.
