Jesus Heals a Man Born Blind

John 9 gives us the miracle of Jesus healing a blind man by spitting on the ground, making mud, and rubbing it on the man's eyes giving him sight for the first time in his life. All of Jesus' miracles took place while on his journeys through the many cities he traveled through and normally his disciples were at his side. It is interesting to see the different reactions from the people who witnessed the miracle...the reactions by the disciples who witnessed the miracle, the person receiving the miracle, or the bystanders (or naysayers) in some instances.

Who do you equate to when you see Jesus working in someone's life that we know was lost or living in sin and now they are a changed person? Are we like the disciples who focus on the defect (sin) and wonder how that person wound up in that situation instead of focusing on the changed person? Are we like the person that received the miracle and now we are on fire wanting to tell others about Jesus, willing to take the criticism from others to tone it down on the enthusiasm? Or are we like the bystanders rejecting the fact Jesus can change someone's life, regardless of the situation because they are spiritually blind.

As we study today, let's use this miracle as a reminder to focus on the positive outcome rather than dwell on the negative past because different routes can be taken to reach the same destination.
