12 Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. 14 And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. 15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.

There are three simple things written here for us to do, but they are very difficult to actually do:

(1) Put on better thinking

- When we think more along the lines of being the chosen ones of God, we think more often about compassion, kindness, others, self-control, and patience. It is amazing how often we forget that God has provided us with a daily opportunity to think about things that will (literally) make our lives better.

(2) Put on better treatment

- When we think more along the lines of being the chosen ones of God, we treat other people in a completely different manner than the rest of the world. Rather than holding grudges, we forgive. Rather than living in competition, we respect the accomplishments of others and celebrate with them. Rather than directing our spite towards others, we understand that pain and hate come from the only enemy we will ever have -- satan himself.
