The disruption of our lives is often difficult to move beyond. Whether that disruption be the loss of a job, the change in status, the loss of a loved one, or maybe the pain caused by someone else, it is hard for us to step on the other side of that disruption. When these things happen, our first instinct is usually one of two actions: (1) lash out at everyone around us or (2) sink deeper into ourselves in hopes that it was all a bad dream.

But what does Scripture say we should do in these moments of pain, grief, sadness, despair?

"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through the fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you. For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior... Because you are precious in my eyes and honored, and I love you... Fear not, for I am with you... everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for glory, whom I formed and made." (Isaiah 43:2-7)

Pause in the disruption, take stock of where you are and who you are, but most of all, remember who created you and His constant presence in your life.
