I went to Maywood in the 10th and 11th grades and enjoyed my experience (sort of), but it did not make a lasting impact on me.

In February of 2002, Rachael and I started dating and she informed me that one of her 'non-negotiables' was a trip every summer to the outskirts of the booming metropolis of Jasper, Alabama to a church camp. With the only exceptions being COVID and one year where I had to leave early due to viral meningitis, my family and I have spent this week growing and enjoying Indian Creek Youth Camp.

Why write this lengthy post? Because we have numerous families with kids from ages newborn to 19 who would greatly benefit from giving this
