It is becoming less and less normal to see people conversing with one another and when those conversations stop, sadly there may be fewer and fewer who come to know the saving love of Christ.

"A weary traveler stopped at a small diner just before closing. His clothes were dusty, his boots worn, and he counted change carefully before ordering the least expensive meal. Several people quietly assumed he was lazy, unsuccessful, or looking for a handout.

As he finished eating, an elderly woman accidentally dropped her purse. Before anyone else moved, the traveler knelt, gathered every item, and handed it back with a smile. She thanked him and recognized him immediately. He was the owner of a local construction company who had spent the day working alongside his employees at a disaster site after flooding. He had skipped going home because he wanted to make sure his crew was fed first. The room fell silent. The people who had judged him by his appearance suddenly realized how wrong they had been."
